

**To become a member** of the Sacred Heart Conference of St. Vincent de Paul the requirements are:

- To be an **Active member** a person must attend two Sacred Heart Conference meetings (this can be either the Spiritual Mass on the second Tuesday of each month or the General Meeting on the last Tuesday of each month) and regularly attend Sacred Heart Conference meetings after that. An active member must also attend Formation Training and Safe Environment Training. An Active Member must be Catholic.
- To be an **Associate member** a person must attend two Sacred Heart Conference meetings (this can be either the Spiritual Mass on the second Tuesday of each month or the General Meeting on the last Tuesday of each month) and attend Safe Environment Training. An Associate member is encouraged to attend Formation Training and regularly scheduled Sacred Heart Conference Spiritual Masses and General Meetings. An Associate Member does not need to be Catholic.

These are the only requirements to be an active or associate member of Sacred Heart Conference. All are welcome to join Sacred Heart Conference that meet these criteria. It makes no difference if they are past or current clients of Sacred Heart Conference. As with any new member they are placed in a volunteer position that best fits their background and SVdP need.
